

Workplace learning is about learning in the workplace rather than in the classroom. It is *the learning* that happens during casual, part-time or full-time work, volunteer work, work experience, work placement, part-time traineeships or enterprise activities.

**Workplace learning programs** are approved and organised by a school or TAFE college to give you planned opportunities to experience the world of work while you are still at school. You can watch work being done, get involved in the workplace, ask questions, learn skills and find out more about careers in the industry. If you are doing workplace learning, you can use the knowledge and skills you have learned in the classroom in a real work environment. You can see how the workplace runs and what is important to getting the job done.
